Pine Lake Co-op Preschool Parent Responsibilities

Pine Lake Co-op preschool is a parent run organization; your participation is key to its success. Below is a list of expectations that each family is responsible for fulfilling as a member of our cooperative preschool.

Parent Responsibilities for 3s, 3.5-4s & PreK Programs:

- Volunteer in classroom (1-3 times per month depending on class enrollment number). The Parent Coordinator for each class creates the monthly schedules.
- Attend monthly evening parent education meetings, for adults only. Meetings are held in the parents' homes of the preschool children, not at the preschool. You may choose to host a meeting in your home or to bring snacks to a meeting.
- Participate in one Work Party during the school year. Examples of past work parties include Adopt-A-Street, rake and/or replenish mulch in playground, paint, assist at PLCP Farmer's Market Information Table, etc.
- Hold a Parent Helper position. Certain roles are Pine Lake Co-op Board positions and require attendance at an additional monthly evening meeting, others require less time obligation. Parents select their role from a list of available options at the Spring Orientation Meeting.
- Pay an Annual Cleaning Service Fee of approximately \$40.00 per family, due at Fall Orientation.

Parent Responsibilities for Arts & Sciences Lab:

- Volunteer in the classroom 1 to 2 times per session.
- Attend an Orientation Meeting prior to beginning your first session.
- Attend regular Parent Education classes regarding parenting and family life issues. Attendance at two Parent Education classes per session is required.
- Current Members of PLCP will not need to meet the Parent Education Requirement for this class, as long as they attend all other meetings for the Preschool Class.
- The Lab class will provide a parent representative to each Board meeting.
